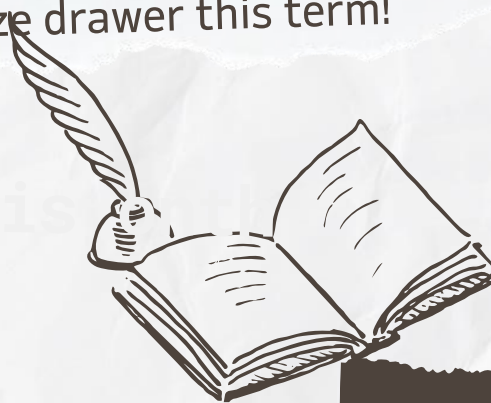
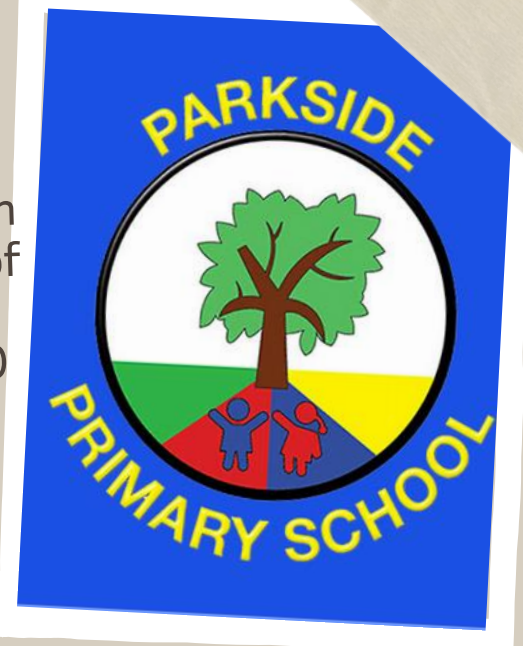
Dear Parents,

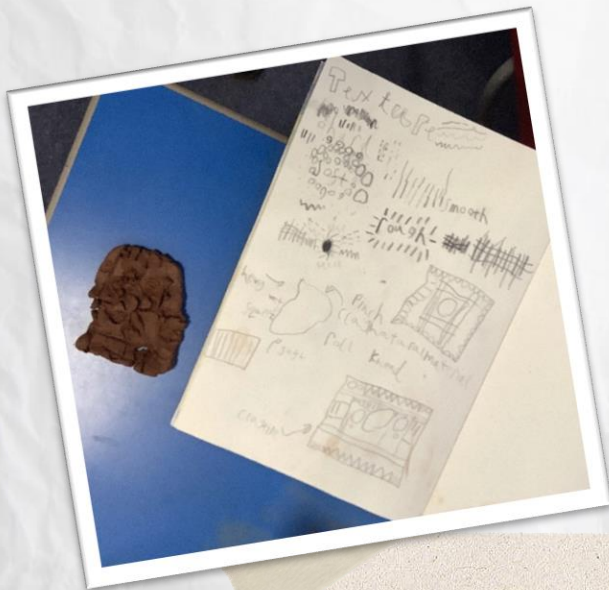


Weekly Spotlight
