
The first week back has flown by and our children have all been happy to return to school

It was wonderful to hear many families sharing details of the reading that their children do at home. Reading at home, with your children, is shown to positively impact on their progress and attainment across the curriculum.

"Regularly reading to a child for the love of it provides a connection between parent and child from the very early days and helps build strong family ties" National Literacy Trust



At Parkside, we ask that parents record the reading done at home via Boom Reader. We appreciate that our families have busy lives and may struggle to find the time to fill out the comment. If this is the case, you simply use 'thumbs up' to log your child's reading. As part of our homework policy, we do expect reading at home to be done four times per week.

You can also set up a Pupil log in for your child. This way, your child can log if they have read with a parent at home.


