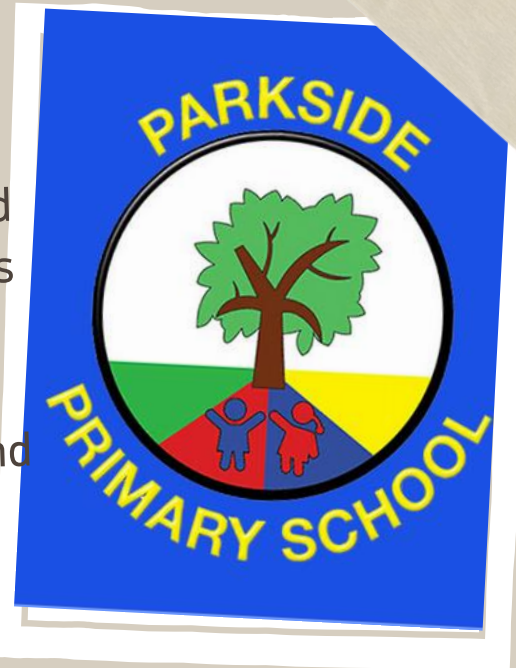


PROUD TO BE PARKSIDE WEEKLY NEWSLETTER 12.04.24
