Another week has flown by at Parkside! We have been continuing to refine our outstanding offer of Personal Development.

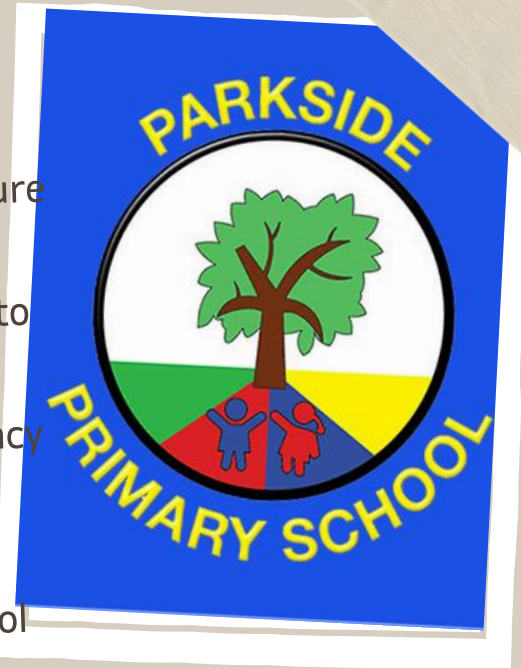
Our Preschool children enjoyed their trip to Wolseley Nature Reserve.
