

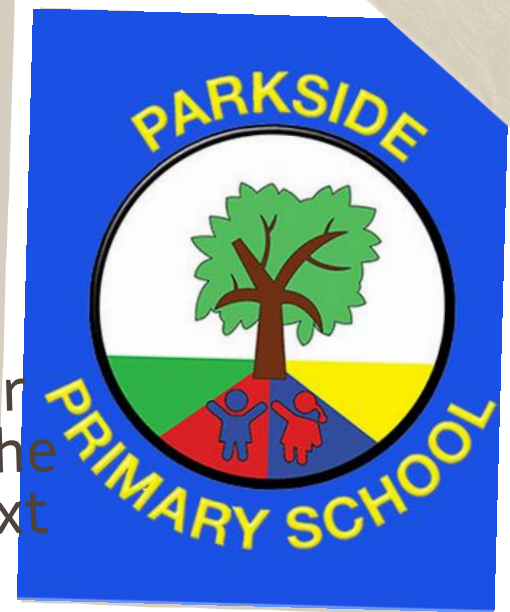
# PROUD TO BE PARKSIDE WEEKLY NEWSLETTER

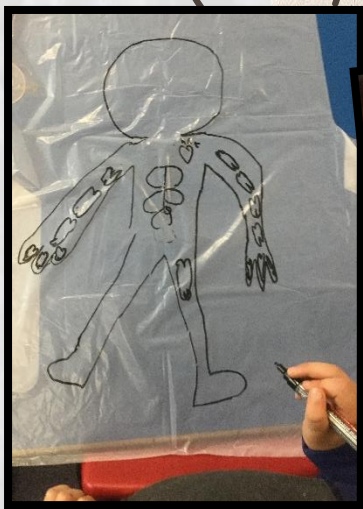
# Weekly Spotlight Science Learning



Years 1 and Year 2 have been exploring the human body this week, including drawing their own bodies on an apron, making a skeleton using biscuits and exploring their senses.

Years 3 and 4 have been exploring rocks and fossils. They have been sorting and comparing rocks and have had a go at making some model fossils. They have also explored how soil is made.

Years 5 and 6 have been learning about Earth and space. They have made their own mnemonics to remember the planets in our solar system and have made a model solar system using fruit. They used torches and balls to explore why we have day and night and can describe the movement of the planets in our solar system.
