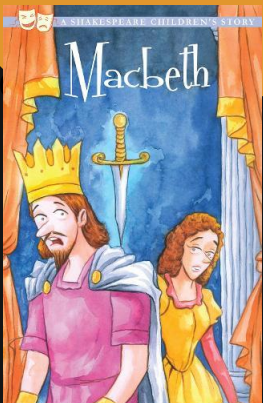
Parkside Pantry

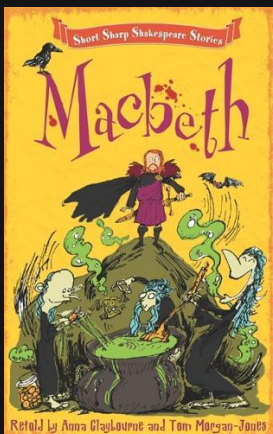
