Our Parkside Pantry is looking a little low this week. If anyone is able to make donations of pasta, rice and pasta sauces we would very much welcome it.

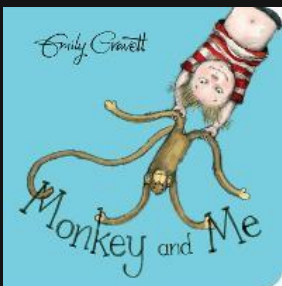
Our Parkside Pantry is available for everyone within our school and our local community. If you would like a bag of items making up for you then please do not hesitate to contact the school office.

PRIMARY SCHOOL ADMISSION SEPTEMBER 2023

If your child is due to start school next September you will need to submit an **online** application. The application process opens on **1 November 2022**.

Applications can be submitted at www.staffordshire.gov.uk/admissions and the deadline is **15 January 2023**.

The online system will ask for a UID number—please click 'No UID', this will allow you to continue with your application. You will receive the outcome of your application on 17 April 2023. Please make your neighbours and friends aware if they have children due to start school.

The CYP Covid Vaccination Team are carrying out walk in clinics to include 1st dose, 2nd dose and autumn boosters to those children between the ages of 5 and 11 if eligible. If you child is aged between 12 and 17 we are able to administer 1st and 2nd doses and autumn boosters to those children that are eligible for a booster.

Your child is eligible if:

- They are aged between 5 years and 17 years (had to be 5 years old on or before 31st August 2022)
- Have not received a Covid vaccination before
- If had a 1st dose needs to be 12 weeks before 2nd dose (8 weeks if Clinically vulnerable)
- They live with someone who is immunosuppressed
- Had 2nd vaccine 12 weeks prior and now require an Autumn booster – only clinically vulnerable or living with someone immunosuppressed or someone age 16 or 17 years who are carers.
- Have not had Covid 19 infection within last 12 weeks (28 days if clinically vulnerable)

Consent needs to be given by a parent or guardian with parental responsibility or delegated authority
